

Guidelines for Outdoor Family One-on-One Visits During Phase 2 of Reopening

Visits for Scottish Home and MacLean House residents will be held in the Red, Red Rose Garden.

- Please arrive 10 minutes early and park near the Red, Red Rose Garden.
- You will see a tent adjacent to the garden. Please remain in your car until you see that there are no other visitors in the tent. When it's clear please meet our dedicated Caledonia Senior Living team member there.
- In the tent you will receive a fresh KN95 mask, complete our questionnaire and have your temperature taken.
- If you have brought store-bought flowers for your family member please ask for a wipe to wipe them down. We will have wipes and hand sanitizer available in the tent. Our team will sanitizer tables and chairs between visits.
- Once you have completed your screening you will be escorted to a designated visitor table. Please make sure your chair is positioned and remains on top of the green X.
- You must remain seated at the table and physically distanced at all times and keep your mask on.
- Our team member will be available the duration of your visit should you have questions or need assistance.

To keep our community safe and healthy please observe the following precautions:

Wear the mask we provide at all times

Physically distance (six feet minimum) from staff and your loved one – keep your chair on the “X mark”

Refrain from kissing, hugging and touching

Ask for a wipe and wipe down any store-bought flowers you bring for your loved one.
